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***Important: You must review and sign the following agreement before your Application will be processed by The Bread Bakers Guild of America***

**1) Public Relations/Marketing by the Applicant and His/Her Employer (if applicable)**

- A. All press releases concerning the applicants must either be issued by or approved by The Bread Bakers Guild of America before being released.
- B. Neither the applicant nor his/her employer may use the Bread Bakers Guild logo to promote to market or promote the applicant's or the company's products or services.
- C. Neither the applicant nor his/her employer may agree to or set up appearances that are promoted by using applicant's status in the competition process.
- D. Applicants may not do advertising or promotions for donors without permission from The Bread Bakers Guild of America.
- E. Applicants may not do any type of interviews (written, radio, TV, or Internet) related to the competition without written permission from The Bread Bakers Guild of America.
- F. Neither the applicant nor his/her employer may use any formulas created by selected Candidates and/or Commis to market or promote the applicant's or the company's products or services.

**2) Appearance Requirements**

- A. Once selected, Candidate/Commis are required to be available for media interviews before, during and after the Mondial du Pain. The Bread Bakers Guild of America will pay for all travel expenses related to attending these events. The Guild will attempt to accommodate schedule conflicts.
- B. Candidate and Commis are required to be available to travel to educational/promotional events scheduled by The Bread Bakers Guild of America before, during, and after (up to two years following) the end date of the Mondial du Pain. The Bread Bakers Guild of America will pay for all travel expenses related to attending these events. The Guild will attempt to accommodate schedule conflicts.
- C. Candidate and Commis are required to attend photo shoots and promotional events for donors scheduled by The Bread Bakers Guild before, during and after (up to two years following the Mondial due Pain. The Bread Bakers Guild of America will pay for all travel expenses related to attending these events. The Guild will attempt to accommodate schedule conflicts.

**3) Release of Formulas**

- A. All formulas created in the process of preparing for the Mondial du Pain or used by the Mondial du Pain become the property of The Bread Bakers Guild of America, which may copyright them under U.S. copyright law and/or international treaties. Applicant agrees to take whatever steps may be required or advisable to secure The Guild's ownership of, and copyright of, the formulas.
- B. All formulas indicated in 3A may be released to the media or general public only by The Bread Bakers Guild of America.

**4) Timeline of This Agreement**

- A. This agreement becomes valid on the date signed by the applicant and remains valid until two years after the end date of the Mondial du Pain
